About ISBER

The International Society for Biological and Environmental Repositories (ISBER) is the leading international forum that addresses the technical, legal, ethical, and managerial issues relevant to repositories of biological and environmental specimens. ISBER has enjoyed substantial growth and increased international recognition in the last several years. Founded in 2000, ISBER now resides at the forefront of the global biorepository community with membership representing over 28 countries worldwide. ISBER became a Division of the American Society for Investigative Pathology in 2005.

ISBER educational resources and meetings focus on technical issues such as quality assurance and control, regulations, human subject privacy and confidentiality issues, and provide information about sources of equipment and expertise. ISBER assists vendors in recognizing the needs of repositories for the development of new products and services, and provides information about existing repositories and their specimen collections.

The goals of the society include:

- Dissemination of information on repository management issues
- Education and sharing of information within the society
- Providing a voice for repositories on shipping, human subjects, legal and ethical issues, etc.
- Developing and promoting repository best practices
- Provision of centralized information resources for existing repositories

The guidelines offer practical recommendations on environmental and human repository management to effectively represent international best practices, and consider regulatory compliance as well as the relevant ethical, legal and social issues.
